Any other business**26 March 2018****Layout of the ADR training certificate in accordance with 8.2.2.8.3 in conjunction with 8.2.2.8.5 of ADR – admissibility of additional information****Transmitted by the Government of Germany****Introduction**

1. The ADR training certificate (model in accordance with 8.2.2.8.5 of ADR) contains, on its front under no. 1, the certificate number. In accordance with 8.2.2.8.3 of ADR, the certificate must include an additional security feature such as a hologram, UV printing or guilloche patterns.
2. Such certificates are often copied for company or personnel records or when applying for specialization or refresher training courses. It is easier to match the back and front of the certificate if the number of the certificate is also indicated on the back.
3. At the same time, this would be an additional security feature.

Proposal

4. Germany would like to ask the Working Party to examine and take a decision on whether the number of the certificate on the back of the ADR training certificate can be considered admissible as an additional security feature.
