  - requested the issuance of a version 4.0 of the eTIR Reference Model containing chapters 1 to 4

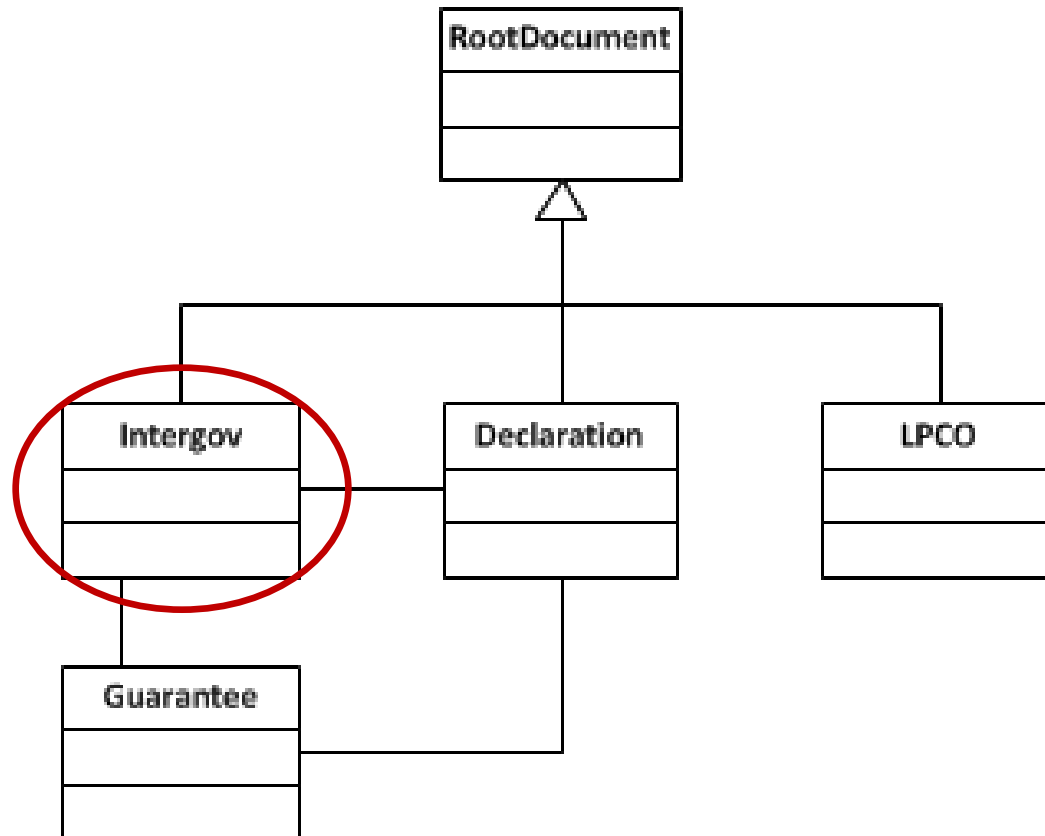
# Inter-sessional work

- The secretariat :
  - Created an amended complete Reference model containing chapter 1 to 4
  - Actively contributed to the inclusion of C2C messages in the scope of the WCO DM v.3.3
- With the assistance of Dutch Customs:
  - All eTIR messages have been mapped to the new WCO DM v.3.3

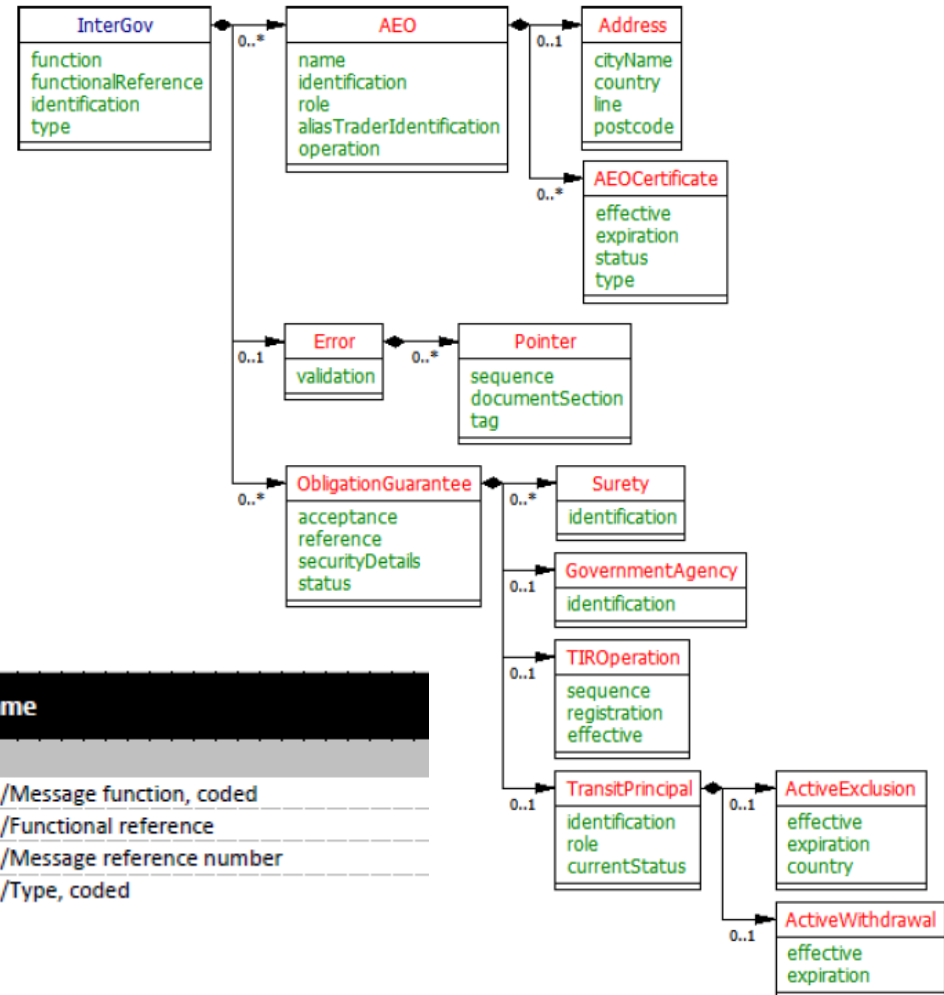
# Scope of the WCO Data Model

- Up to version 3.2
  - B2C and C2B messages (i.e. declarations and responses)
- Since version 3.3
  - Licences, certificates and permits (e.g. CITES)
  - C2C information exchange (GNC)

- Include the new messages in the eTIR RM v.4 and distribute it to eTIR focal points for review
- Generate new XSDs (and UN/EDIFACT mapping)
- Submit eTIR RM v.4 to WP.30
