CUSTOMS CONVENTION ON THE TEMPORARY IMPORTATION  
OF PRIVATE ROAD VEHICLES

NEW YORK, 4 JUNE 1954

SUDAN: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 16 October 2003.

The Convention will enter into force for the Sudan on 14 January 2004 in accordance with its article 35(2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying or acceding to the Convention after the date of the deposit of the fifteenth instrument of ratification or accession in accordance with the preceding paragraph, the Convention shall enter into force on the ninetieth day following the date of the deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification or accession either without reservation or with reservations accepted in accordance with article 39."
