CUSTOMS CONVENTION ON CONTAINERS, 1972

GENEVA, 2 DECEMBER 1972

AZERBAIJAN: ACCESSION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 17 January 2005, with:

Reservation (Original: English)

The Republic of Azerbaijan does not permit the empty and loaded containers going to and coming from the Republic of Armenia, as well as the containers belonging to the legal and physical persons and the persons controlling and exploiting containers, registered in the Republic of Armenia, to enter into its territory.

The Convention will enter into force for Azerbaijan on 17 July 2005 in accordance with its article 19 (2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying, accepting, approving or acceding to the present Convention after the deposit of the fifth instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession, the present Convention shall enter into force six months after the date of the deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession."
