ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY THE CZECH REPUBLIC,
THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF GREECE
TO ANNEX I OF THE AGC¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.255.2001.TREATIES-1 of 28 March 2001 concerning the amendments proposed by the Czech Republic, the Republic of Moldova and the Government of Greece to Annex I of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of the above depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 11, the proposed amendments are deemed to be accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of article 11, the amendments to the Agreement will enter into force for all Contracting Parties three months after the date of this notification, i.e., on 1 January 2002.
