EUROPEAN AGREEMENT ON MAIN INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC ARTERIES  
(AGR)

GENEVA, 15 NOVEMBER 1975

ALBANIA: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Agreement will enter into force for Albania on 1 October 2006 in accordance with its article 6 (2) which reads as follows:

"For each State which deposits its instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession after the commencement of the period of 90 days specified in paragraph 1 of this article, the Agreement shall enter into force 90 days after the date of deposit of the said instrument".
