EUROPEAN AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE CONVENTION ON ROAD
TRAFFIC OPENED FOR SIGNATURE AT VIENNA ON 8 NOVEMBER 1968

GENEVA, 1 MAY 1971

MOLDOVA: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 25 April 2007, with:

Declarations (Courtesy Translation) (Original: Moldovan)

"Until the full re-establishment of the territorial integrity of the Republic of Moldova, the provisions of the Convention shall be applied only on the territory controlled effectively by the authorities of the Republic of Moldova."

"Pursuant to the provisions of the art 11, the Republic of Moldova does not consider itself bound by the art 9 of the Agreement."

The Agreement will enter into force for Moldova on 25 April 2008 in accordance with its article 4 (2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying, or acceding to, this Agreement after the deposit of the tenth instrument of ratification or accession, the Agreement shall enter into force twelve months after the date of deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification or accession."
