CONVENTION ON ROAD SIGNS AND SIGNALS

VIENNA, 8 NOVEMBER 1968

AZERBAIJAN: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 22 February 2011, with:

Reservation (Original: English)

“In relation to paragraph 1 of Article 46 of the Convention, the Republic of Azerbaijan declares that it doesn’t consider itself bound by Article 44 of this Convention.”

Declaration (Original: English)

“The Republic of Azerbaijan declares that it is unable to guarantee implementation of the provisions of the Convention in its territories occupied by the Republic of Armenia, until the liberation of those territories from the occupation and complete elimination of consequences of that occupation ...”

Notification (Original: English)

“According to paragraph 2 of Article 46 of the Convention, the Republic of Azerbaijan declares that it chooses the model A^a as a danger warning sign and the model B, 2^a as a stop sign in the territory of the Republic of Azerbaijan.”

The Convention will enter into force for Azerbaijan on 22 February 2012 in accordance with its article 39 (2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying or acceding to this Convention after the deposit of the fifteenth instrument of ratification or accession, the Convention shall enter into force twelve months after the date of deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification or accession."
