EUROPEAN AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE CONVENTION ON ROAD
SIGNS AND SIGNALS
GENEVA, 1 MAY 1971
AZERBAIJAN: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 11 July 2011, with:

Reservation (Original: English)

“In relation to Article 11, the Republic of Azerbaijan declares that it does not consider itself
bound by Article 9 of this Agreement.”

Declaration (Original: English)

“The Republic of Azerbaijan declares that it is unable to guarantee implementation of the
provisions of the Agreement in its territories occupied by the Republic of Armenia, until the liberation
of those territories from the occupation and complete elimination of consequences of that occupation...”

Notification (Original: English)

“In accordance with Article 6 (8), the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of
Azerbaijan (Address: AZ1005, Baku city, Azerbaijan avenue 7) is the administration competent in the
matter of agreement as contemplated in Article 6 (7) of the above-mentioned Agreement.”

The Agreement will enter into force for Azerbaijan on 11 July 2012 in accordance with its
article 4 (2) which reads as follows:

"For each State ratifying, or acceding to, this Agreement after the deposit of the tenth
instrument of ratification or accession, the Agreement shall enter into force twelve months after the date
of deposit by such State of its instrument of ratification or accession."
