Paragraph 6.3., amend to read:

"6.3. The intensity of the light emitted in all directions in which the light can be observed shall not exceed:

300 candelas in directions in or above the horizontal plane; and, in directions below the horizontal plane:

600 candelas between h-h and $5^{\circ}D$ and 8000 candelas below $5^{\circ}D$."
