<u>Note</u>: The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from GTB in order to clarify the measuring procedure in the Regulation, in the case when filament lamps of Regulation No. 37 are used for the driving beam in addition to Regulation No. 99 gas-discharge light source.

Paragraph 6.3.2., amend to read:

"6.3.2. It is possible to use several light sources for the driving beam, these light sources being listed in either Regulation No. 37 (in this case the filament lamps shall be operated at their reference flux) or Regulation No. 99. The following provisions shall be met:
