

**Terms of Reference.**

Tasks	To consider in detail, the task of producing the text of a Global Braking Regulation, taking account of the Contending Regulations which already exist and are in substantial use.
Process	To follow the guidelines set out in Trans/WP29/882 for the development of this GTR.
Compilation	<p>To produce the Regulation requirements which draw on existing texts in the braking field but, within sensible limits, lean toward the acceptance of the more stringent standards.</p> <p>This is to be done consistent with remaining practical and workable by differing organisations in various countries.</p> <p>Every attempt is to be made to ensure that the completed text will be understandable to users who are not seasoned experts in the development of Braking Regulations.</p>
Scope	To cover passenger vehicles of [Category 1-1] as listed in TRANS/WP29/GRSG/2003/10
Time Scale	The target is to submit a draft Regulation which includes up-to-date technology to the GRRF <sub>59</sub> meeting of February 2006.
Meetings	<p>The anticipated time scale allows for 5 main meetings before the 59th GRRF.</p> <p>Meetings will, wherever possible be linked to the GRRF sessions. However, additional meetings, possibly of a smaller Group may, where necessary, be included in between these GRRF-linked meetings.</p>
