

**DRAFT CORRIGENDUM  
TO THE DOCUMENT TRANS/WP29/GRSG/2003/10  
(Draft GTR on Masses and Dimensions)**

**Transmitted by the expert from Japan**

Para 3., insert new paragraph:

**“3.1. References in gtrs to categories of vehicles shall be in accordance with annex 1.”**

Para 3.1 to 3.3., amend to read:

**“3.2. References in gtrs to categories of vehicles shall be in accordance with annex 2.**

**3.3. References in gtrs to masses of vehicles shall be in accordance with annex 3.**

**3.4. References in gtrs to dimensions of vehicles shall be in accordance with annex 4.”**

Annex 3, Para6.2., amend to read:

“Passenger mass” means the nominal mass of a passenger that shall be 68 kg **except:**

in the case of Category 1-1 vehicle, **where** each passenger must additionally have 7 kg provision for luggage which shall be located in the luggage compartment(s) in accordance with ISO standard 2416–1992, and

~~In the case of category 1-2 vehicle designed to carry standing passengers, no provision for baggage is required.~~

in the case of category 1-2 vehicles not designed to carry standing passengers, **where** each passenger must have 3 kg additional provision for hand baggage.”

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
