Pilot questionnaire on transport of gas through pipelines

<u>Note</u>: In view of the interest of the Working Party to be informed about various national systems for the transport of gas through pipelines, the Government of Bulgaria has prepared a document which is reproduced below.

National gas-pipeline system

On the territory of Bulgaria, there is a motorway gas-pipeline through which gas is transported for Bulgaria and for some neighbouring countries. The National Statistics Institute makes a three-month specific statistics survey on the motorway gas-pipeline with which data is provided for the transported quantities of gas on the respective destinations and for the completed job, measured in ton-kilometers from the gas-pipeline. The data provided by the survey is confidential, since at this stage the measured unit is only one.
