OUTSTANDING ISSUES OR PROPOSALS OF AMENDMENTS TO THE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

Comments on ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2004/85 (EIGA) and UN/SCETDG/26/INF.27 (USA)

Introduction

- 1. The Expert of Belgium agrees with the intent of the EIGA proposal ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2004/85.
- 2. The point of view of the United States of America, given in UN/SCETDG/26/INF.27, that exceptions should not take the form of a note and that the amendment would create confusion with respect to the refrigerated liquefied gases, is also valid.
- 3. The proposals of the United States of America however will create new problems. With their 2.2.2.1 (b), it is impossible for a dissolved or a refrigerated liquefied gas to be non-flammable, non-toxic! Moreover, a definition is not the appropriate place to address the field of application of the Model Regulations.

Proposals

- 1. Redraft the first sentence of 2.2.2.1.(b) as proposed by EIGA (eliminate the words "are transported at a pressure not less than 280 kPa at 20 °C, or as refrigerated liquids, and which".
- 2. Introduce a new 2.2.2.3, as follows:
 - "2.2.2.3 Gases of Division 2.2, other than refrigerated liquefied gases, are not subject to these Regulations if they are transported at a pressure less than 280 kPa at 20 °C."
