Draft amendments to Annexes A and B of ADR

Addendum 1

This document contains an additional list of amendments to annexes A and B of ADR adopted by the Working Party at its seventy-sixth session (3-7 May 2004) for submission for acceptance to Contracting Parties to ADR and for entry into force on 1 January 2005 (See TRANS/WP.15/179).

PART 1

Chapter 1.1

1.1.3.2 (f) In the English version of the document, replace "pressure tanks" with "pressure vessels".

Chapter 1.6

1.6.3.30 Amend the new paragraph in TRANS/WP.15/178 to read as follows:
"Vacuum-operated waste fixed tanks (tank-vehicles) and demountable tanks constructed before 1 July 2005 in accordance with the requirements applicable up to 31 December 2004 but which do not conform to the requirements of 6.10.3.9 applicable as from 1 January 2005, may still be used."

1.6.4.20 Amend the new paragraph in TRANS/WP.15/178 to read as follows:
"Vacuum-operated waste tank-containers constructed before 1 July 2005 in accordance with the requirements applicable up to 31 December 2004 but which do not conform to the requirements of 6.10.3.9 applicable as from 1 January 2005, may still be used."

1.6.5.9 Add a new transitional measure to read as follows:
"1.6.5.9 Tank-vehicles with fixed tanks with a capacity of more than 3 m³ intended for the carriage of dangerous goods in the liquid or molten state tested with a pressure of less than 4 bar, which do not comply with the requirements of 9.7.5.2, first registered before 1 July 2004, may still be used."

Chapter 5.3

5.3.1.1.2 Replace "transport units" and "transport unit" with "vehicles" and "vehicle" respectively.
