## MISCELLANEOUS PROPOSALS OF AMENDMENTS TO THE MODEL REGULATIONS ON THE TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

## Special Provisions 61 and 274

## Transmitted by the expert from Italy

For all pesticides entries, in column 6, both the following Special Provisions have been assigned:

- 61 The technical name which shall supplement the proper shipping name shall be the ISO common name, other name listed in the WHO Recommended Classification of Pesticides by Hazard and Guidelines to Classification or the name of the active substance (see also 3.1.2.8.1.1).
- 274 For the purposes of documentation and package marking, the proper shipping name shall be supplemented with the technical name (see 3.1.2.8).

SP 61 seems to be appropriate for pesticides, while SP 274 seems to be redundant.

It is then proposed to delete SP 274 for all pesticides entries (as in ADR/RID/ADN).

Moreover it is proposed to **modify** SP 61 (as in ADR/RID/ADN), making reference to the ISO standard, as in the followings:

61 The technical name which shall supplement the proper shipping name shall be the ISO common name (see also ISO 1750:1981 "*Pesticides and other agrochemicals - common names*", as amended), other name listed in the WHO "*Recommended Classification of Pesticides by Hazard and Guidelines to Classification*" or the name of the active substance (see 3.1.2.8).
