Description of Regulations

FMVSS 135 – Passenger Car Brake Systems

Standard No. 135 specifies requirements for passenger vehicle service brakes and associated parking brake systems. The purpose of the regulation is to ensure safe braking performance under normal and emergency driving conditions. It applies to all passenger cars manufactured after September 1, 2000 and to multi-purpose passenger vehicles, trucks and buses with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 3,500 kilograms (7,716 pounds) or less, manufactured on or after September 1, 2002.
