

GRSP Informal Group – Head Restraints  
4<sup>th</sup> Meeting

Tentative proposed wording from OICA to define a head restraint, replacing the current proposed section 3.3.2:

3.3 . "Head restraint" means a device that limits rearward displacement of the seated occupants had relative to the occupant's torso;

3.3.1 . "Integrated head restraint" means a head restraint, formed by the upper part of the seat-back. The area to be considered is: above the plane perpendicular to the torso reference line at [700] mm from the R point between two vertical longitudinal planes passing at [85] mm on either side of the torso reference line. Head restraints which are non-adjustable and which can only be detached from the seat or the vehicle structure by the use of tools or by partial or complete removal of the seat covering, meet the present definition;

3.3.2 ." Adjustable head restraint" means a head restraint consisting of a component moving separately from the seat and designed for insertion and positive retention in the seatback structure;
