

Dear Colleagues,

We believe that the comments issued Mr. Gaupp ([secretary's note: EVSC06-21](#)) and the reaction given by Colin Ross ([secretary's note: EVSC06-23](#)) should be discussed in GRRF.

The question on the principles is a matter of GRRF.

GRRF could during the 57<sup>th</sup> meeting last year not agree with the principles of design restrictive requirements.

If some experts are going to introduce the design restrictions again, they have to send their comments to GRRF.

The current proposal drafted by the informal group, also on the basis of comments and guidelines given by GRRF, is a compromise based on these statements and can be justified for that reason.

The assessment of the performance is far from perfect. We believe that the development of more precise test procedures asks for more time than needed for the introduction of EVSC systems.

Up to now it is not unusual to introduce new requirements whereby test procedures need further adjustment.

GRRF has to decide in which way further progress can be made without delaying the introduction of EVSC systems.

So we don't see the need for an additional meeting in Frankfurt.
