Desensitized Explosives

Informal Working Group on Desensitized Explosives

Transmitted by the expert from Germany

1. As stated on the last meetings of the Sub-Committees on TDG and GHS, Germany will host an informal intercessional working group on desensitized explosives with the following tasks (UN/SCEGHS/13/INF.19):
 - a) To develop a classification scheme suitable to classify desensitized explosives in part 2 of the GHS.
 - b) To develop a proposal for suitable hazard communication elements for desensitized explosives.
2. The meeting is intended to be an open and informal working group, with the purpose of helping the Sub-Committees on TDG and GHS to implement desensitized explosives appropriately in the GHS.
3. It is intended to have a one day meeting on Monday 17 December 2007 in Berlin, at Federal Institute for Material Research and Testing (Bundesanstalt für Materialforschung und -prüfung, BAM), Unter den Eichen 87. 12207 Berlin.
