

GRSG, at its ninety-third session, agreed to recommend for adoption by AC.3 a draft gtr on Safety Glazing (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2007/28, as modified by GRSG-93-24).

The head-form test and two paragraphs concerning markings were left in square brackets for policy decision by AC.3. Informal document WP.29-143-05 proposes a solution for the head-form test.

Concerning the markings, AC.3 proposes the deletion of the paragraphs, which were left in square brackets by GRSG. The markings paragraphs are reproduced below:

"4.1.            Markings

4.1.1.            General requirements for markings.

4.1.1.1.          All marking shall be clearly legible from at least one side of the glazing, indelible, and at least 3 mm in height.

~~4.1.1.2.          Every glazing shall bear the following markings: Global glazing manufacturer identification mark, gtr mark, identification mark(s).~~

~~4.1.1.3.          Contracting Parties may require additional markings.~~

4.1.2.            Identification marks.

Each piece of glazing shall bear the appropriate marks set out in this section.

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
