

Clarification for draft amendment to the proposal for the 11 series of amendments to  
Regulation No. 13 (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2007/106)

The table reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the UK. It is aimed at clarifying the numerous permutations of ESC fitment to vehicles with different braking systems contained in the implementation table outlined in paragraph 12.4.1.

<sup>3</sup> Class B - vehicles not designed to carry standing passengers; a vehicle of this class has no provision for standing passengers
