Proposal for a draft corrigendum to Regulation No. 66

(Strength of superstructure)

A. PROPOSAL

<u>Paragraph 1.</u>, amend to read (including the insertion of a reference to footnote $\underline{*}/$ and the corresponding footnote $\underline{*}/$):

"1. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to single-deck rigid or articulated vehicles designed and constructed for the carriage of more than 22 passengers, whether seated or standing, in addition to the driver and crew. */

*/ Nothing in this Regulation shall prevent the Contracting Parties from restricting the scope to Class II and Class III vehicles (as defined in Annex 7 to the Consolidated Resolution on the Construction of vehicles (R.E.3), (document TRANS/WP.29/78/Rev.1/Amend.2 as last amended by Amend.4))."

B. JUSTIFICATION

- 1. It was recognized by GRSG that the original footnote as an editorial mistake is left out from the scope of Regulation No. 66.01.
- 2. There is a formal proposal in ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2006/22 to put back this footnote in the scope.
- 3. Spain proposed to modify the scope itself in ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2007/2.
- 4. If there is a need to bring in harmony the existing practice with the scope of Regulation No. 66.01 GRSG should modify the footnote as proposed above.
- 5. GRSG should not extend the scope of Regulation No. 66.01 before the proposal of the expert group IG/R.66 without studying the technical conditions.

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
