The sixth meeting will be held at the Federal Statistical Office of Germany (Wiesbaden) on 25-26 September 2008.

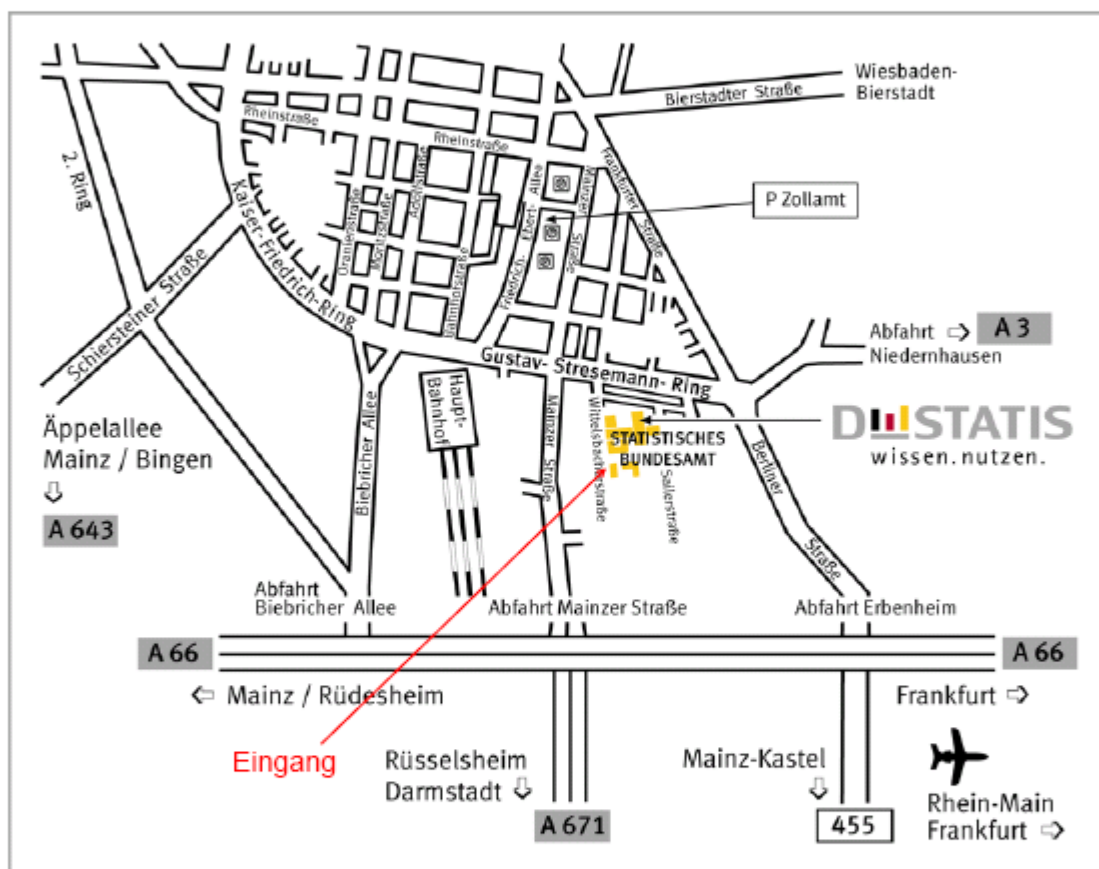
