1. <u>4.1.4.1, P003, third sentence</u>

- <u>For</u> Outer packagings constructed of suitable material of adequate strength and designed in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use shall be used.
- <u>Read</u> Outer packagings constructed of suitable material, and of adequate strength and designed in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use, shall be used.
- 2. 4.1.4.1, P904 (1), second sentence
- <u>For</u> Outer packagings constructed of suitable material of adequate strength and designed in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use shall be used.
- <u>Read</u> Outer packagings constructed of suitable material, <u>and</u> of adequate strength and designed in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use, shall be used.

3. 4.1.4.1, P907, second sentence

- For Dangerous goods in machinery or apparatus shall otherwise be packed in outer packagings constructed of suitable material of adequate strength and design in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use, and meeting the applicable requirements of 4.1.1.1.
- Read Dangerous goods in machinery or apparatus shall otherwise be packed in outer packagings constructed of suitable material, and of adequate strength and design in relation to the packaging capacity and its intended use, and meeting the applicable requirements of 4.1.1.1.
