**RESOLUTION NO. 40, "INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE
FOR OPERATORS OF PLEASURE CRAFT"**

Amendments to Resolution No. 40

Proposal submitted by the European Boating Association

Note by the secretariat

At its thirty-third session, the Working Party recommended that the fifty-second session of the Working Party on Inland Water Transport should approve the proposal to amend Resolution No. 40 with the aim to enable Administrations to deliver the international certificates (ICCs) for operators of pleasure crafts to operators others than their nationals and residents. The Working Party also supported the proposal to create an annex to the resolution listing the competent bodies delivering ICCs (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/66, para. 21). The draft amendment to the Resolution and the draft annex were submitted to the Working Party on Inland Water Transport as document ECE/TRANS/SC.3/2008/16. At its fifty-second session, the Working Party on Inland Water Transport took note of these recommendations but considered that an additional work on the wording of the amendments should take place to alleviate concerns of some countries on the new scope of the resolution (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/181, paras. 45-46).

At the SC.3/WP.3 thirty-fifth session, the Working Party did not reach an agreement on the amendment to paragraph 1 of the resolution (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/70, para. 29).

The Working Party may wish to consider the revised proposal by the European Boating Association together with the latest draft Annex 4 on the competent bodies delivering ICCs. At this occasion, the Working Party may also wish to consider dedicating a part of its thirty-seventh session on 23-25 June 2010 to the issue of recreational navigation.

AMENDMENTS TO RESOLUTION NO. 40 ON INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE FOR OPERATORS OF PLEASURE CRAFT

1. Page 1, line 14

For paragraph 1 substitute

Recommends the issue, by the competent authority or by bodies approved by implementing Governments, on request and if the requirements set forth in annex 1 are satisfied, of an international certificate concerning the competence of operators of pleasure craft (“international certificate”) to their own nationals or residents or to the nationals of any North American country or any country that is not a member of the Economic Commission for Europe, provided they are holders of the implementing Government’s national certificate or have passed an examination in accordance with Annex 1, Part 1, paragraph 2 where this is accepted by the implementing Government.

The international certificate should conform to the models in Annexes 2 or 3 to this resolution and should be made out in the official national language or languages, the title of the document being given, if possible, in two of the three languages English, French and Russian.
