#### Introduction

1. In 8.6.3 the model of the ADN Checklist is given. 7.2.4.10 states that a check list for the cargo in question has to be completed. There is, however, no reference in the model to what is meant by “Name of product”. The model does not say where to find the UN Number, Identification number or Class.
2. It is proposed, therefore, to add to the model of the ADN Checklist some references to the transport document and to Table C. The “Name of product” is substituted by the terminology found in 5.4.1.1.2.
3. During discussion the question arose whether the packing group should be added to the ADN Checklist. At least for some products the packing group is considered important information (e.g. for UN 1170 ETHANOL SOLUTION the packing group determines the tank design).
