The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its sixty-fourth session. It is based on informal document GRE-64-14, as reproduced in Annex III to the report. Additional lamps satisfying all the position, geometric visibility, colorimetric and photometric requirements for the above indicated lamps shall be activated when the apparent surface in the direction of the reference axis of these lamps is more than 50 per cent hidden by the movable component; or"
