


Summary of Proposal

- A vehicle is considered to fail if any of the following three conditions are satisfied:
 - 1. The vehicle fails the Annex 3 conditions;
 - The vehicle fails the "No worse than today" (KBA) check;
 - 3. The vehicle fails both the RPM based method and the L_Urban method.




