Current proposed label will not be understood correctly by Japanese, which do not use Alphabet characters in general.



Easy survey were done to 25 employees in 2 Japanese CRS producing company.

Only 5 person could understood correctly, 20 person misunderstood meaning of "0-15M".

Concern : Which CRS needs to have this label ?

In the case of Child Restraint Systems **that can be used forward facing**, it shall have the following label permanently attached and visible to someone installing a child restraint in the vehicle (the information shown is a minimum):

label minimum size 40 x 40 mm



	Type of CRS	0-15M label	
1	Rearward facing	NA	
2	Rearward facing and Forward facing	A	
3	Forward facing	NA or A	
4	Lateral facing	NA	
5	Lateral facing, Rearward facing & Forward facing	A	

Users of Type-3 (Forward-only facing CRS) may be confused have a label which has a tick on non-existing installation direction.

Users of Type-5 (Lateral, Rearward and Forward facing CRS) may be misunderstand that Lateral Facing installation is NOT allowed.



Proposal : 1 There will be 2 different descriptions of “DO NOT” in one CRS. It is better to unify in one description.
