### Proposal for Amendment 3 to Special Resolution No. 1 (S.R.1)

#### Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling \*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its sixty-seventh session to introduce a definition of manufacturer. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2012/17, superseded by Annex XI to the report (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/67, para. 20). It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Executive Committee AC.3 for consideration.

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\* In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2010–2014 (ECE/TRANS/208, para. 106 and ECE/TRANS/2010/8, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

*Annex 1, insert a new paragraph 9. to read:*

- "9.            *"Manufacturer"* means the person or body who is responsible to the approval authority for all aspects of the type approval process and for ensuring the conformity of production. It is not essential that the person or body is directly involved in all stages of the construction of the vehicle or component which is the subject of the approval process."
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
