Special provision PP48

Transmitted by the expert from France¹

1. During its last session the Sub-Committee adopted some changes to PP48 in packing instructions P112(c), P114(b)and P406 clarifying what could be considered as a non metallic packaging.

2. The expert from France explained that the adopted text could be improved by referring to metal parts allowed in non metallic packagings as mentioned in 6.1.4.

3. The Sub-Committee invited the expert from France to present a written proposal (see paragraph 23 in ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/90).

Proposal

4. Modify packing provision 48 as follows in the different packing instructions where it appears (new text underlined)

(a) Packing provision 48 in packing instruction P114(b):

PP 48: For UN Nos. 0508 and 0509, metal packagings shall not be used. Packagings incorporating a small amount of metal, but which are primarily comprised of non-metallic materials, are not considered metal packagings.
