Proposal

5. Insert a new paragraph 1.4.10.4.4 in Chapter 1.4 of the GHS to read as follows:

“1.4.10.4.4 Use of ~~GHS~~-pictograms during transport

For transport, a ~~GHS~~-pictogram not required by the UN Model Regulations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods should only appear as part of a complete GHS label (see 1.4.10.5.4.1), and not independently as may be the case for ~~a-in~~ transport ~~pictogram regulations~~. The size of the ~~GHS~~-pictograms should be proportional to the size of the text of the other label elements, and should be smaller than the transport ~~-related pictograms placards or labels~~ to create a visual distinction. Such size adjustments should not affect the clarity or comprehensibility of the non-transport pictograms.”
