Subject: European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous goods by Inland Waterways (ADN) : Recognition of classification societies according to sub-section 1.15.2.4.

Dear Sirs,

Based on the subsection 1.15.2.3. the Regulations annexed to the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Inland Waterways (ADN), which form an integral part thereof, the Administrative Committee has established a list of classification societies recommended for recognition by the Contracting Parties to the ADN, which is listed, among others, is also Ukrainian Register of Shipping.

Ministry of Maritime Affairs, Transport and Infrastructure, Directorate for Maritime and Inland Navigation, Shipping, Ports and Maritime Domain, Sector for Inland Navigation has received a request from the Ukrainian Register of Shipping in which they request recognition of their classification society.

After considering the request, and receiving a positive opinion from the Croatian Register of Shipping, Ministry of Maritime Affairs, Transport and Infrastructure under subsection 1.15.2.4. the Regulations annexed to the ADN, which states that each Contracting Party may decide to recognize the recommended classification society, has decided to recognize Ukrainian Register of Shipping, which is on the list of recommended ADN classification societies.

The Secretariats are kindly asked to forward the information as it is foreseen in the ADN regulations.
