The Workshop is hosted by the Government of Turkmenistan and will be held back-to-back with the SPECA Thematic Working Group on Sustainable Transport, Transit and Connectivity.

The aim of the Workshop is to strengthen the capacities of SPECA and East-European countries for gathering reliable and comprehensive road transport and road safety statistics.

The capacity building workshop will be focused on how to gather relevant statistics and share them in such a way as to allow national policy makers to make informed decisions. The Workshop would seek to assist in understanding the methodology for gathering Road Transport and Road Safety Statistics as well as how best to make this information available to decision-makers, the road transport community and the general public.

The data collection process at UNECE level and the Web Common Questionnaire (WebCoQ) will be presented. Regional Road Safety Goals, Targets and Indicators for Asia and the Pacific will be presented by ESCAP. Furthermore, invited experts will present European best practice in road transport and road safety data collection. Representatives of SPECA and East-European countries will present their national data collection mechanisms and key successes/difficulties in data collection.
