Proposal for Supplement 22 to Regulation No. 23 (Reversing lamps and manoeuvring lamps)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its seventy-seventh session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/77). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2017/7 and Annex IV to ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/77. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee AC.1 for consideration at their June 2017 sessions.

Supplement 22 to Regulation No. 23 (Reversing lamps and manoeuvring lamps)

Paragraph 5.4.1., amend to read:

"5.4.1. The reversing lamp or manoeuvring lamp shall only be equipped with light source(s) approved according to Regulation No. 37 and/or Regulation No. 128, provided that no restriction on the use is made in Regulation No. 37 and its series of amendments in force at the time of application for type approval or in Regulation No. 128 and its series of amendments in force at the time of application for complexity the time of application for type approval."
