
Proposal for Supplement 6 to the 01 series of amendments to Regulation No. 119 (Cornering lamps)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its seventy-seventh session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/77). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2017/7 and Annex IV to ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/77. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee AC.1 for consideration at their June 2017 sessions.

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Supplement 6 to the 01 series of amendments to Regulation No. 119 (Cornering lamps)

Paragraph 5.4.1., amend to read:

"5.4.1. The cornering lamp shall only be equipped with light source(s) approved according to Regulation No. 37 and/or Regulation No. 128, provided that no restriction on the use is made in Regulation No. 37 and its series of amendments in force at the time of application for type approval or in Regulation No. 128 and its series of amendments in force at the time of application for type approval."
