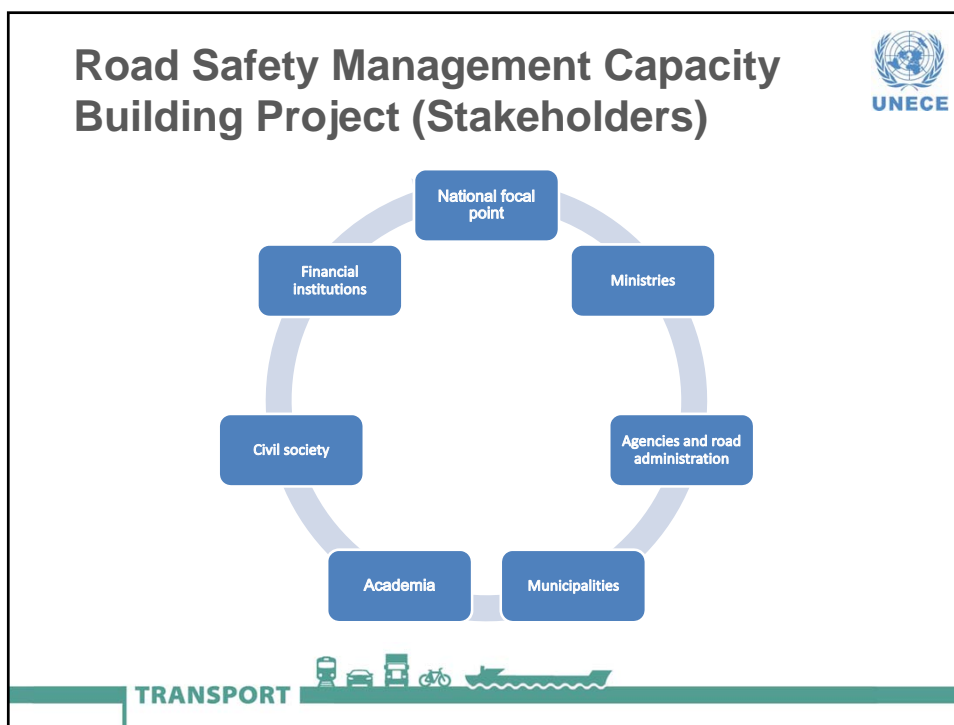
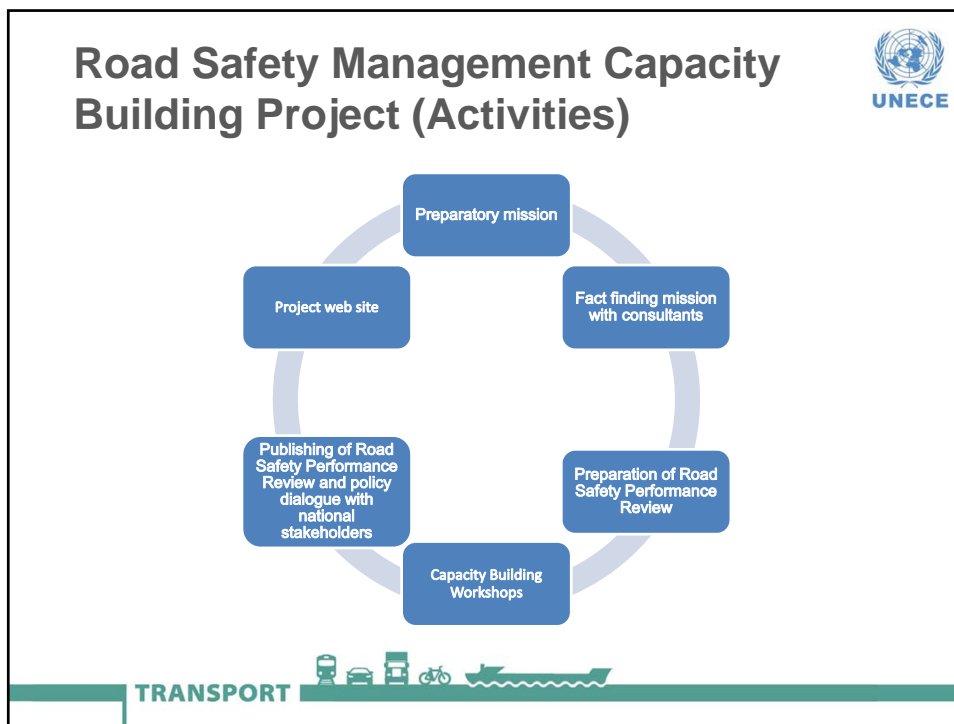


Road Safety Management Capacity Building Project
