(a) Work of the RID/ADR/ADN Joint Meeting

The Safety Committee may wish to note that the RID/ADR/ADN Joint Meeting at its spring 2018, autumn 2018 and spring 2019 sessions adopted draft amendments to RID/ADR/ADN. The Safety Committee may also wish to consider these proposed amendments taking into account those adopted by the Working Party on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (WP.15) at its 105th and 106th sessions (ECE/TRANS/WP.15/244, annex I and ECE/TRANS/WP.15/246, annex).

The Safety Committee may wish to note that at its next autumn 2019 session, the RID/ADR/ADN Joint Meeting will consider proposals of harmonization with the 21st revised edition of the United Nations Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods, contained in ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2019/22 and Add.1.
