In Palestine ...

- 45% of the Palestinian population are children (Under 18 years old).
- The number of school students reached about 1.3 million.
- ❖ 80% of students are in primary school (6-12 years old) .

| Year | Total Numbers Of pedestrians crashes | Numbers Of Fatalities (Under 18 years old) |
|------------------------|--|---|
| 2018 | 1278 | 42 |
| Jan 2019 - Aug 2019 | 852 | 25 |

> In 2018 <u>about 3.4</u> pedestrians crashes occurred every day .

Policies

Procedures to improve the safety of school students.

- Provide a safety zone in the surrounding of school areas by road safety audit.
- Intensifying traffic awareness for school students.
- Improving traffic safety requirements in school buses (such as Road crossing assistant, Warning lights, Reverse camera, etc.)
- Constant inspection of student transport buses by Road Safety patrols and traffic police.
- Updating the Palestinian Traffic Law .
- Update the school bus production year.

Road safety challenges for school students.

- Lack of pedestrian facilities .
- Weakness in law enforcement.
- Overspeed.
- Most of schools entrance are located on the main street.
- funding of road safety projects.
- obstacles on the sidewalks.
- Behavior of road users (Poor traffic awareness).

Policies to improve road safety for school students

- □ Improve road safety infrastructure (Installation /sidewalk, Pedestrian crossings, Speed humps, handrail, etc.)
- Reducing and controlling speed in school and pedestrian areas.
- Increase the presence of police and road safety patrols near school entrances.
- Intensify inspection of safety equipment in school buses.
- □ Increase road safety education at primary and secondary schools.
- Activate penalty points (Black Points) on traffic violations.
