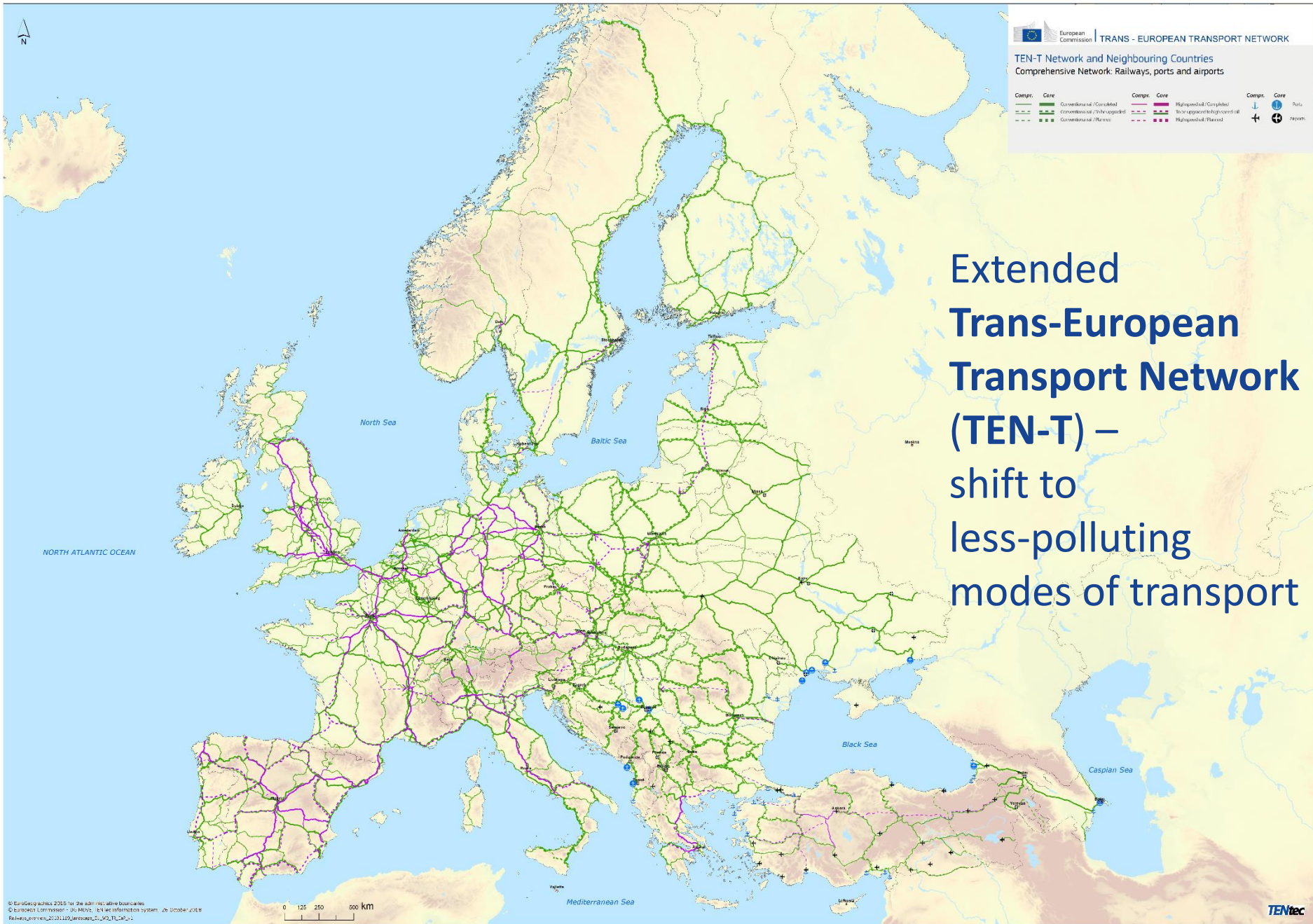

## **Sustainable connectivity: sustainable networks**

- **Aviation:** Single market -> Single European Sky
- **Road transport:** efficient, safe, secure and environmentally friendly mobility; fair competition; harmonising standards
- **Rail transport:** strong and competitive rail transport industry
- **Maritime transport:** preventing sub-standard shipping, reducing the risk of accidents, minimising environmental impact
- **Inland waterways:** strengthening the competitive position of inland waterways in the transport system
