
ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES 12, 13 AND 14 OF THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.533.2013.TREATIES-XI.D.5 of 7 August 2013 concerning the amendments proposed to articles 12, 13 and 14 of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of twelve (12) months following the date of the above depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 12, the proposed amendments are deemed to be accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 12, the amendments to the Agreement will enter into force for all Contracting Parties three (3) months after the expiry of the period of twelve (12) months from the date of the above notification, i.e., on 7 November 2014.
