

Objectives of TEM project

- to facilitate co-operation between road managers and experts

- 65th Steering Committee 16-17 December, Vienna, Austria and workshop on Environmental Impact Assesment





Outcomes 2015 (1)

- 64th Steering Committee agreed to prepare 3 reports based on workshop:
- 1. Road safety
- 2. Strategy for the TEM project for next years
- 3. Diverse sources of financing the projects
- Exchange of knowledge and experiences with HEEP representatives and potential of cooperation in 2016
