## Accident data: diversity all over the world

\* ESC mandatory will lower the number of side impact

- Europe: vehicles will have to be equipped with ESC due to CE 661/2009
  - M1/N1 => New Type 01/11/2011, All Vehicle 01/11/2014
  - M2/N2 => New Type 11/07/2013, All Vehicle 11/07/2015
- > USA: FMVSS 126 makes ESC mandatory in M and N vehicles
  - All Vehicle 01/09/2011
- > Australia: ESC mandatory (ADR 31/02)
  - New Type 01/11/2011, All Vehicle 01/11/2013

No clear justification for a GTR on pole side impact



## **Candidate procedures**

- Need for a cost/benefit study for each of the candidate procedures
- \* A test program to investigate on these procedures was launched by France
- \* The results will supplement the Australian/Canadian program
  - > Test configurations
    - 90°, 29 km/h WorldSID 50<sup>th</sup>
    - ✓ 75°, 32 km/h WorldSID 50<sup>th</sup>
