MONTENEGRO: SUCCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 23 October 2006, with confirmation of the reservation made  
by Serbia and Montenegro<sup>1</sup> upon accession<sup>2</sup>:

Reservation (Original: English)

“The provisions of article 12 in connection with article 13 of the Agreement are not binding on  
Serbia and Montenegro.”

The date of State succession for Montenegro is 3 June 2006.
