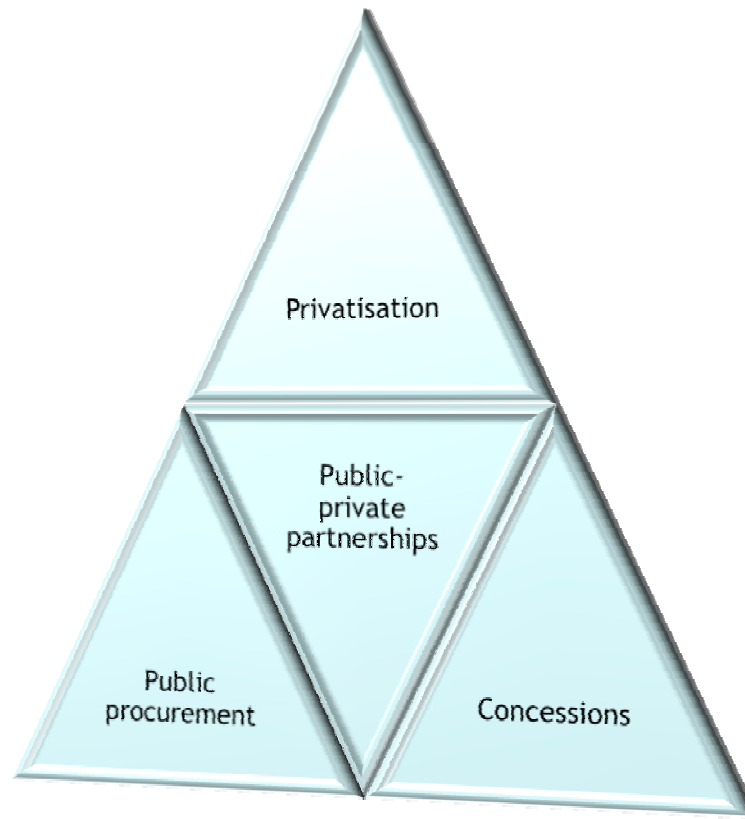

SEE on the PPP map

- Projects in emerging markets will require \$1 trillion in capital in the next 10 years
- SEE will provide projects \$50 - \$100 billion, which puts it high on the PPP map
- But PPP capacity is low with countries closer to EU having more experience and opportunities for development (EBRD)

PPP in PPPs' governance

- Some examples of PPPs in “soft” issues: anti-corruption/good governance (SELDI and Coalition 2000)
- PPPs will not make a difference if they are not supplemented by better governance and transparency
- Capacity building is at the heart of better governance
