# **T&T Domain Closing Session**

1. Present Status of the T/T Projects

All of SLH related projects completed and presently in the maintenance phase. CUE will be updated.

DTI project is still alive and is to be continued to make its exit in a year or so. We will request its extension.

2. Green Paper Provision on Experience Program

Discussed a lot on the paper and we could get very good guides from Harm Jan and Lance. The draft version on the paper will be provided the Bureau after further discussion in the coming AFACT meeting.



3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage SLH International Pilot Project

The project is progressing slowly and will further be discussed in the coming AFACT Meeting.


4. Potential T/T Reference Data Model
