News / Comments

- The SCRDM based CCBDA Invoice schema has been approved and included in the European Norm (EN)
- The new CCBDA based process driven XML schemas will become modern alternatives to any previously published document driven XML schemas
- More process driven XML messages may be derived from the Supply Chain Reference Data Model, such as the Scheduling messages
- A Mini Conference on Reference Data Models (SCRDM and MMT RDM) will be held this afternoon at the Forum
