Transport and Logistics Partnership (TLP) in Central Asia

Goals and objectives:

- TLP activities are aimed to develop a regional cooperation in the transport and logistics sectors in Central Asia for trade promotion and trade facilitation between Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan.
- TLP is not a legal entity as it's a regional professional dialogue platform (forum) that unites the national transport partnership in four countries.
- Private-Public Dialogue as the TLP members are permanent members of the National Trade Facilitation Bodies.



Transport And Logistics Partnership (TLP) in Central Asia

Activities / results:

- Analysis of legislations on international road transportation in the Central Asian region was conducted and the common legislative problems are identified for discussion in the NTFBs.
- Analysis on weight and size requirements for trucks was conducted and will be discussed with the Ministries or Transport of Central Asia soon.
- Issues of mutual recognition and issuing of the International Vehicle Weight Certificates were agreed and discussed with the Customs Services of Central Asia.
- Monitoring of transit corridors for export of agricultural products from Central Asia was conducted (2017 and 2020) and recommendations are discussed with the NTFBs.
- Exploration of new economic transit routes (UZ-TJ-China in 2019)
- Expansion of TLP's activities within the SPECA region
- Promotion of the Public-Private Dialogue mechanism through the NTFBs





- Participation in 2 Steer Processes on regional and national levels through the Regional Network Meetings of NTFBs by support of GIZ and NTFBs meetings on national level
- Promotion of common Central Asian priorities: access to information, transit, transborder procedures etc.
